RESIDENTIAL TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE

MONDAY, WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY: Collection days, place trash out **no later than 7:00AM.**

SUNDAY, TUESDAY & THURSDAY: Night before collection, place trash out AFTER 5:00PM.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING: FRIDAY ONLY by 7:00AM.

Use CLEAR two-ply bags or covered wheeled containers. Blue bins are being discontinued. Please use CLEAR bags. *Combine in the same bag: Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, brown bags, white/colored paper, telephone books, flattened cereal boxes & milk cartons, cleaned plastic, glass and cans.*

STARVE THE RATS! TRASH BAGS ATTRACT RATS!!

Keeping trash bags off the streets until 7:00AM on collection days will reduce the opportunity for rats to feed. Thank you!

TRASH BAGS & CONTAINERS:

Two-ply (black) bags. Covered containers with tight-fitting lids.

- NO kitchen trash bags. NO CVS bags. NO open bags or containers.
- All bags and containers must be securely tied and covered.

APPLIANCE PICK-UP by appointment only.

AVOID VIOLATIONS & FINES:

NO household or commercial trash in City barrels. Violations carry fines up to \$1000 per day.

NO building/construction materials with residential collection.

DO NOT dispose of trash on property other than your own.

STREET SWEEPING PROGRAM

APRIL 1 - NOVEMBER 30

- Signs are posted with days & times for each street. Avoid fines by knowing the schedule for your street.
- Cars will be TICKETED @ \$40.00 and TOWED @ \$110 if they are on the street before the sweeper goes by.
- Cars may return to parking after the sweeper has passed.

DAILY CLEANLINESS

- Residents and merchants are responsible for SWEEPING the SIDEWALKS and GUTTERS in front of their property.
- Restaurant and residential DUMPSTERS must have lids and be CLOSED AT ALL TIMES.
- Pet owners are responsible for picking up after their pets and disposing of it properly. PET WASTE ATTRACTS RATS!!

SNOW REMOVAL & ALERTS

- Property owners must ensure that the sidewalk area in front of their property is kept clear of snow and ice.
- Register for KNOWSNOW program for Snow Emergency alerts. Go to www.cityofboston.gov/alerts

TRASH REGULATIONS

- **Place regular trash out Monday, Wednesday and Friday by 7:00 AM*** or after 6:00 PM on Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday.
USE ONLY HEAVY-DUTY BLACK PLASTIC TRASH BAGS.
 - **DO NOT** use paper/grocery bags, kitchen bags or CVS-type bags.
 - **Place Recycling out Friday ONLY, by 7:00 AM, or after 6:00 PM Thursday.**
USE ONLY TWO-PLY CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS.
The City's blue bins are being discontinued, clear bags are preferred.
 - **NO TRASH OF ANY KIND ON THE STREETS ON SATURDAYS.**
You will get a **TICKET** if you put regular trash or recycling out at any time other than times indicated above.
 - Carts for trash or recycling should be brought in from the curb after collection.
 - Report trash violations to Code Enforcement at 617-635-4896 or call the **MAYOR'S 24-hour HOTLINE** at 617-635-4500.
- * *Placing trash out as close as possible to 7:00 AM on collection days will keep the streets cleaner and will reduce food sources for rats.***
